- Examination/Competition Entry upon Teacher/Student/Parent agreement (*This may incur an extra cost*)
- Accompanist Fees are to be paid directly to Accompanist (*where applicable*)
- Extra lessons with accompanist are charged at normal lesson rates
- Instrumental Students will be offered places in relevant ensembles at Teacher discretion, lessons may be used in lieu of a formal audition
